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VISA SUPPORT



DOCUMENTS FOR CROSSING THE BORDER

To avoid encountering any problems when crossing the border, all foreign participants arriving from abroad are required to bring the following documents with them:

IF YOU NEED A VISA TO ENTER THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

You must bring the following to cross the border:

- a visa
- a valid passport
- a medical insurance policy valid on the territory of the Russian Federation (if needed)

IF YOU DO NOT NEED A VISA TO ENTER THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

You must bring the following to cross the border:

- a valid passport
- a medical insurance policy valid on the territory of the Russian Federation (if needed)



OBTAINING A VISA

If you need a visa to enter the Russian Federation, you can apply for one of the two following types of visas:

- 1) **a visa through an invitation for foreign arrivals** (for all International Arctic Forum participants);

OR

- 2) **an electronic visa** (available for citizens of 64 foreign countries).

VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

After submitting all the required documents, Forum participants can obtain a short-term, single-entry Russian visa **for the period from 19 March to 3 April 2025** at foreign consular offices of the Russian Federation on the day of their application.



HOW TO APPLY FOR A VISA BY INVITATION FOR FOREIGN ARRIVALS?

An invitation for foreign arrivals is not an invitation to the International Arctic Forum, but a separate document from the Forum organizers, which is available in the [Roscongress personal account](#).

1. All confirmed participants will receive an official invitation to the International Arctic Forum by email.
2. After receiving the invitation, log in to your [Roscongress personal account](#) using your personal login and password.
3. Go to the 'My events – International Arctic Forum – Event dashboard – Visa support' tab of the [Roscongress personal account](#).
4. Your personal information will be automatically uploaded from the Roscongress personal account to the document. You can manually add the city and country where you will be applying for your visa.

You can contact a Roscongress Foundation specialist to make changes to the personal data. The specialist's contact information can be found in the [Roscongress personal account](#) and in your invitation letter.

5. Download and print the invitation for foreign arrivals.
6. Provide your Russian consular office with the invitation for foreign arrivals and the other required visa documents. Information about the location of Russian consular offices can be found on the website of the [Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation](#).

E-VISA

Can be issued to citizens of 64 foreign countries:

Austria, Barbados, Bahrain, Belgium, Bulgaria, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Eswatini, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Iran, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Kenya, The Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Kuwait, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Myanmar, Netherlands, North Korea, Northern Macedonia, Norway, Oman, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Saint Lucia, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkmenistan, Turkey, Vatican, Vietnam, Zimbabwe.

VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

The unified electronic visa is a single-entry visa. **The validity of the single electronic visa is 60 days** from the date of issue.

The permitted period of stay in the Russian Federation on a single electronic visa is **not more than 16 days from the day of entry** within its validity period.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR AN E-VISA?

To apply for a unified e-visa, it is necessary to fill in an application on the purpose-made [website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia](#). **The unified electronic visa is not free.**

Applications may be submitted **not earlier than 40 days and no later than 4 days** before the expected date of entry into the Russian Federation.

FLIGHTS TO MURMANSK

Emperor Nicholas II Murmansk International Airport is located 24 km from the city centre. Up-to-date information can be found on the [airport website](#) and is available at the offices and on the websites of the airlines.

There are direct flights to Murmansk from Moscow, St. Petersburg, Kazan, Kaliningrad, Arkhangelsk, and Cherepovets.

TRANSFER IN ST. PETERSBURG

If there are no direct flights between your departure city and Murmansk, you can choose a flight with a transfer in St. Petersburg. The direct flight from St. Petersburg to Murmansk takes **approximately 2 hours**.

There are currently direct flights to St. Petersburg from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Egypt, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, PRC, UAE, Serbia, Türkiye, Thailand, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan.

Pulkovo Airport (LED) is St. Petersburg's only airport that serves scheduled domestic and international flights. For the latest information, please visit the [website of Pulkovo Airport](#) and your airlines of interest. Alternatively, you may contact airlines directly.

TRANSFER IN MOSCOW

The flight time from Moscow to Murmansk is approximately **2 hours 30 minutes**.

HOW TO GET TO THE VENUES?

All venues are located near Pyat Uglov, Murmansk's central square, and are within walking distance of each other.

The estimated travel time from Murmansk Airport to the Forum venues is approximately one hour by car.

FROM THE AIRPORT

- **By public transportation:**

Bus or minibus route No. 106.

Interval: 20–30 minutes.

Travel time: approximately one hour.

Stop: Pyat Uglov square.

- **By car/taxi:**

Travel time: approximately one hour.

Parking areas: the hotel offers an open, unattended parking area with a barrier. Rates are RUB 200 per day for hotel guests and RUB 100 per hour for non-guests.

Free public parking areas are also available near both venues.

- **By shuttle bus:**

FROM THE RAILWAY STATION

AZIMUT City Hotel Murmansk and the Kirov Palace of Culture are within walking distance of the railway station, at a distance of 350–550 metres.

ACCESS TO THE VENUES



Upon arrival, each participant will have to go through the access control procedure. The participant may be asked to turn on your phone or laptop and show other equipment that you brought to the venue.

In order to avoid any inconvenience when accessing the venue, participants are advised to leave any items prohibited at the Forum venue at their accommodation or in their vehicle. Please carefully review the [list of items prohibited on the event venue](#) and pay attention to any exceptions.



PARTICIPATION FEE PAYMENT

Payment of the participation fee on time and in full is a prerequisite to receiving a participation badge and gaining access to the International Arctic Forum 2025 venue.

Before making a payment, please make sure that:

1. You have received your invitation to International Arctic Forum 2025.
2. You have confirmed your participation in the Forum in [Roscongress personal account](#).
3. You are approved for paid participation in the Forum.

The payment date will be considered **to be the day on which the amount due is credited to the account of the Roscongress Foundation**.

The participation fee may only be paid by the individual or legal entity indicated as the Customer in the invoice agreement.

CREATING A PAYMENT DOCUMENT

You can proceed to payment if the Organizing Committee has approved your application for participation, you have received your invitation to the International Arctic Forum 2025 and confirm participation in the Forum via the [Roscongress personal account](#).

1. Enter the payer's information via the [Roscongress personal account](#) (make sure you enter the information of the individual or legal entity making the payment).

Changes to payer's information can only be made by your Roscongress Foundation specialist. The contact information can be found in the [Roscongress personal account](#) or by contacting the Forum information centre by phone at + 7 (499) 700 0607.

2. Select the payment method:

- for residents of the Russian Federation: invoice in roubles or bank card for residents;
- for non-residents of the Russian Federation: invoice in roubles/US dollars/euros or bank card.

3. Select the type of payment document: **agreement** or **invoice agreement**.

To pay by agreement, you should:

- save your participation agreement
- send a signed copy of the agreement to your Roscongress Foundation specialist. The contact information can be found in the [Roscongress personal account](#)
- save a payment document in the 'Payment' section on [Roscongress personal account](#)
- pay the participation fee

To pay by invoice agreement, you should:

- save your invoice agreement to make the payment
- pay the participation fee

Acceptable payment forms include Visa, Mastercard, American Express, UnionPay, and MIR payment system cards issued by Russian banks and UnionPay payment system cards issued by foreign banks.

HOW TO GET TO THE FORUM VENUES?

01. Receive a badge.

We kindly ask that you collect your accreditation badge in advance at one of the accreditation points.

To pick up your badge, please check that you have uploaded all the necessary data to your [Roscongress personal account](#).

More detailed information is in the ['Badge collection'](#) section.

02. Leave items prohibited at the venue at your accommodations.

Please carefully review [the list of items prohibited on the event venues](#) and pay attention to any exceptions.

03. Don't forget your passport.

Please don't forget to bring along an identifying document (passport) to the venue. You must present your passport at the entrance to the venue and keep it with you while you are located at the Forum venues.

04. To access the Kirov Palace of Culture and Folk Art of the Murmansk Region on 27 March, you need to pass a PCR test and collect a special pass.

Special passes are activated by a negative result of a PCR test. You do not need to take a PCR test to collect your special pass.

You can collect your special pass and then take a PCR test or do it in the reverse order.

BADGE COLLECTION

An accreditation badge is a pass to the Forum venues. We do recommend **receiving your badge in advance**.

You must carry your badge and identity document (passport) with you at all times when at the Forum venues.

The badge is personalized and may not be transferred to third parties.

If your badge is lost or damaged, you should contact any accreditation desk or Help Desk.



WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO PICK UP MY BADGE?

In the 'My events – International Arctic Forum – Event dashboard' section of the [Roscongress personal account](#) you should:

1. Confirm participation in the Forum

2. Enter your personal information in full

in accordance with your passport

3. Upload a required photo for your badge:

- Colour photo against a light background;
- Photo size – 480 × 640 pixels;
- Photo format – JPG or JPEG;
- Full-face photo with no headgear;
- Your face must take up at least 70% of the photo.

Tab 'My events – International Arctic Forum – Event dashboard – Personal information – Photo – Edit data'.

4. Upload a scanned copy of your passport (pages 2 and 3)

Tab 'My events – International Arctic Forum – Event dashboard – Personal information – Edit data'.

Please make sure that the scanned copy is legible and contains complete information about the data you gave when registering, including the series and number of the document, the issue date, the issuing authority, and a photo. Formats: jpg, jpeg, pdf, png.

5. Pay the participation fee

Data processing takes from 3 days.

If changes have been made to your identity document (passport) after you completed the application to participate in the Forum, the data in your [Roscongress personal account](#) must be edited (tab 'My events – International Arctic Forum – Event dashboard – Personal information – Edit data').

To make changes to any fields that are blocked for editing, please contact the specialist that you spoke with when registering for the Forum.



When issuing the badge, the accreditation operator checks the data specified in the [Roscongress personal account](#) to ensure it matches the information in your identity document. If the data does not match, the badge cannot be issued on the day you applied for it.

Please check your personal data in the Roscongress personal account before obtaining the badge.

HOW TO FIND OUT IF MY BADGE IS READY?

There are several ways to find out or be notified when a participant badge is ready:

HOW DO I PICK UP MY BADGE?

Participant accreditation badges may be collected in person by presenting:

- The identity document that is listed in the [Roscongress personal account](#);
- Original of personal data consent form.

HOW CAN I PICK UP MY BADGE BY PROXY?

To pick up a badge for another participant by proxy, the authorized individual must present:

- Passport;
- Original consent of a driver to the processing of personal data;
- List of participants;
- Copies of the passports of all participants to be accredited;
- Originals of personal data consent forms.

PCR TEST TO ACCESS THE KIROV PALACE OF CULTURE VENUE ON 27 MARCH

PCR testing is only required to access the Kirov Palace of Culture on 27 March.

To access **the Kirov Palace of Culture venue on 27 March**, all participants, media representatives, and staff **must undergo PCR testing for COVID-19, influenza A/B and ARVI** 24 hours before visiting the plenary session, but **no earlier than 07:30 on 26 March** (GMT+3) at one of the Forum testing centres.

A PCR test is **not needed**:

- to access the Kirov Palace of Culture on 26 March.
- to access the AZIMUT City Hotel Murmansk on 26–27 March.
- to access the Meridian Congress Hotel on 26–27 March.

A special pass to access the Kirov Palace of Culture on 27 March is activated by a negative result of a PCR test.

Testing will be carried out only at the Forum's dedicated testing centres, which are provided by Rospotrebnadzor. The results of tests taken at other laboratories are not transferred to the Forum's accreditation system.

Results will be provided within 24 hours. **LAMP testing is not provided.**

PCR testing at dedicated Forum testing centres is strictly by appointment only in the [Roscongress personal account](#).

HOW TO GET TESTED?

01. Provide information about COVID-19 immunity in the [Roscongress personal account](#).
02. Find your ID in the [Roscongress personal account](#) and keep it in mind or write it down.
03. Sign up for PCR testing in the [Roscongress personal account](#).
04. Pay for PCR testing.
05. Print, fill out and sign consent forms for medical intervention and to the processing of personal data.
06. Provide your Forum participant ID or show your badge at the Forum testing centre or using the off-site testing

WHEN TO GET TESTED?

To access the venue, all participants, media representatives, and staff must undergo PCR testing for COVID-19, influenza A/B and ARVI 24 hours before visiting the Forum venue, but **no earlier than 07:30 on 26 March** (GMT+3).



WHERE TO GET TESTED?

Testing- will be carried out **only** at the Forum’s dedicated testing centres, which are provided by Rospotrebnadzor in Murmansk, Moscow and St. Petersburg. **The results of tests taken at other laboratories will NOT be accepted for access to the venue.**

Testing is conducted by appointment. The list of approved centres and opening hours is subject to change. Please check for updates.

DATA REQUIRED FOR TESTING

1. Information about your immunity

In order to be admitted for PCR testing, all participants must provide information about their immunity in the [Roscongress personal account](#):

- Information about COVID-19 vaccination status;
- Information about previous coronavirus infection (COVID-19) status;
- Information about the presence or absence of vaccination against influenza and measles;
- Information about having had the measles disease;
- Information about permanent residence and temporary addresses during the Forum.

Please be mindful of the validity periods for proof of immunity:

- Written documentation of exposure to the disease – 1 year;
- Certificate of medical contraindication to vaccination – 1 year;
- COVID-19 vaccine certificate – 1 year.

Certificates obtained more than one year ago need not be uploaded.

2. FORUM PARTICIPANT ID

When taking a PCR test, you must provide your Forum participant ID.



WHERE TO FIND YOUR ID?

- In your [Roscongress personal account](#) next to the participant photo.
- On the badge (under the photo) You can view your ID on your badge, if you have already received it.

If a test is not associated with a participant ID, it will not be possible to send the test results to the Accreditation centre in order to activate the badge to attend the event.

3. Consent forms for medical intervention and to the processing of personal data

You must print, fill out, sign consent forms for medical intervention and to the processing of personal data before visiting the testing centre and bring it with you. **Consent for medical intervention for minors** is filled out on behalf of the legal representative, so fill it out in advance.

Important! Documents must be printed in one-sided format (printing on one side of the sheet only). Forms printed in double-sided format (printing on both sides of the sheet) will not be accepted.

Medical treatment consent forms can be downloaded in the '[PCR testing](#)' section on the Forum website.

PCR testing at dedicated Forum testing centres is strictly by appointment only. Please arrive at the time of your booking.

BOOKING A TEST

In order to book a PCR testing, you must fill in all the required fields of the questionnaire in the 'Data about immunity' section.

For test booking:

1. Go to the 'PCR testing' section.
2. Choose 'Book a test' tab.
3. Choose the most convenient testing centre from the list and select a time slot.

PCR testing is to be paid for separately. Please do not forget to pay for your PCR test.

PAYMENT FOR PCR TESTING

In order to pay for a test, you must provide the Forum participant ID of the person whose PCR test is being paid for.

How do I pay by card via the Roscongress personal account?

1. Go to the 'PCR testing – Payment for PCR testing' section of the [Roscongress personal account](#).
2. Provide medical intervention consent forms for medical intervention and to the processing of personal data.
3. Click the 'Pay' button.
4. Provide your ID and personal data Also, you can provide ID of the person whose PCR test is being paid for.
5. Provide consent for personal data processing (tick the checkbox).
6. Make the payment by card.
7. Tick the field marked 'Get a receipt' and enter your email address in order to request a receipt. A receipt will be provided within 24 hours.

Payments are made in Russian roubles. If the payment does not go through, please contact your bank.

TEST RESULTS

The track titled **'The Arctic and the NSR: Magnetically Attracting Investment'** will consist of sessions on how to improve preferential regimes for Arctic business and develop resources, creative industries, and tourism in the region.

Experts attending **'The Arctic and the NSR: Developing Support Settlements'** will tackle the development of support settlements, state support for imports to the North, standards for businesses dealing with the North's indigenous minorities, and careers in the Arctic.

The **'International Cooperation and the Environment'** track will address how countries interact with one another and strategies for humanitarian and ecological interaction between the government and business, with special attention going to science, geotechnical monitoring, and measures for adapting to the melting of permafrost.

State Council Commissions for the **'Northern Sea Route and the Arctic'**, **'Efficient Transport'**, and **'International Cooperation and Export'** will also be meeting as part of the business programme.

The 'Taste of the Arctic' Food Festival, Ministry of Emergency Situations demonstrations, and the 'Wives of Heroes' Arctic lounge will also be held.

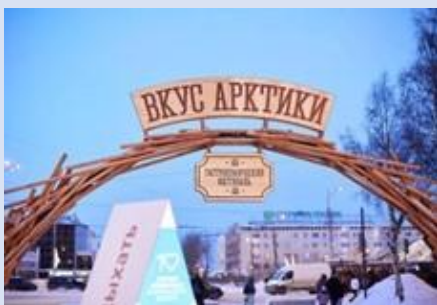

Tour of the Lenin nuclear icebreaker

The Lenin nuclear icebreaker is the first vessel in the world with an atomic propulsion unit. It is the only cultural heritage site of federal importance in the city of Murmansk. More than 500 enterprises and institutions of the USSR took part in building the icebreaker at the Admiralty Shipyard in Leningrad in 1956–1959. It was commissioned on 3 December 1959.

Over the next 30 years, Lenin provided navigational support on the Northern Sea Route and served as an atomic university that accumulated experience from year-round Arctic navigation operations, improved technologies, and trained personnel for the Soviet nuclear fleet.

The icebreaker led thousands of ships through the Arctic ice and traversed some 654,400 nautical miles, more than three times the distance from Earth to the Moon. It was decommissioned in 1989. On 5 May 2009, the Lenin nuclear icebreaker moored at the sea terminal in the centre of Murmansk and quickly became a calling card of the Murmansk Region and one of the most visited tourist sites in the Kola North.

The modern Lenin Nuclear Icebreaker Arctic Exhibition Centre is a structural unit of the Federal State Unitary Enterprise of the Nuclear Fleet (FSUE Atomflot) of the Rosatom State Atomic Energy Corporation.

The meeting point for the group is at the gangway exact location. A passport is required to visit the icebreaker.

All excursions are in Russian, except for 28 March 11:30, at this time there will be an excursion in English.

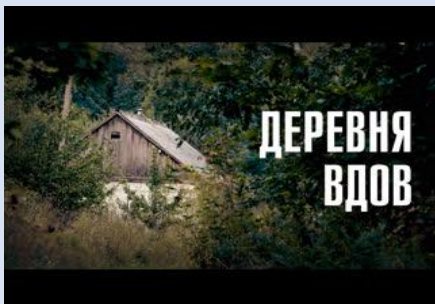

People in the village say not a single one of them ever married again.

The plot is based on the heroic expedition that Soviet submariners took to the top of the Northern Hemisphere in 1962 during a period of heightened confrontation between the USSR and USA. The first Soviet nuclear submarine Leninsky Komsomol passed under the ice pack of the Arctic Ocean and surfaced in proximity to the pole for the first time in world history. The expedition, which was the first of its kind at the time and is comparable in terms of its complexity to the first spaceflights, was intended to demonstrate the power of the latest technologies of the USSR's young nuclear navy and the outstanding skills of Soviet submariners.

The main roles in the film are played by Russian movie stars Andrey Merzlikin, Yevgeny Mironov, and Elena Sever.

CURRENCY AND BANK CARD TRANSACTIONS

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The official currency in Russia is the Russian ruble with banknotes in denominations of 10, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1,000, 2,000, and 5,000 roubles. Current information on exchange rates can be obtained on the website of the Central Bank of Russia: cbr.ru.

Please note the following currency exchange restrictions in the Russian Federation:

- It is not possible to withdraw roubles / foreign currency at an ATM or receive cash at a point of sale using Mastercard or Visa cards issued outside of Russia. These cards can also not be used for the payment of goods and services in Russia.
- Only cash in US dollars or euros can be freely exchanged for cash in roubles in most banks in Russia. Some bank offices can exchange Chinese yuan, United Arab Emirates dirham, Turkish lira and cash in other currencies.
- For currency exchange operations you must present an identity document. If the exchange exceeds the equivalent of USD 10,000, it must be declared in writing.

BANK CARDS

Given the existing restrictions on the use of foreign bank cards in Russia, we recommend that you carry cash with you for the entire duration of the Conference.

Mir and UnionPay cards in any currency work without restrictions in Russia. Forum participants are advised, where possible, to apply for a card or bring an existing card from either of these payment systems. *Please note the UnionPay cards are not accepted at all retail outlets. Additionally, failures may occur when using these cards, and transactions may not go through.*

WEATHER IN MURMANSK

Murmansk is located above the Arctic Circle, and the weather here is unpredictable even in spring.

In late March, the average temperature is around -3°C , but frequent winds can make it feel significantly colder. Snowfall and frost are possible. Please check the weather forecast before departure.



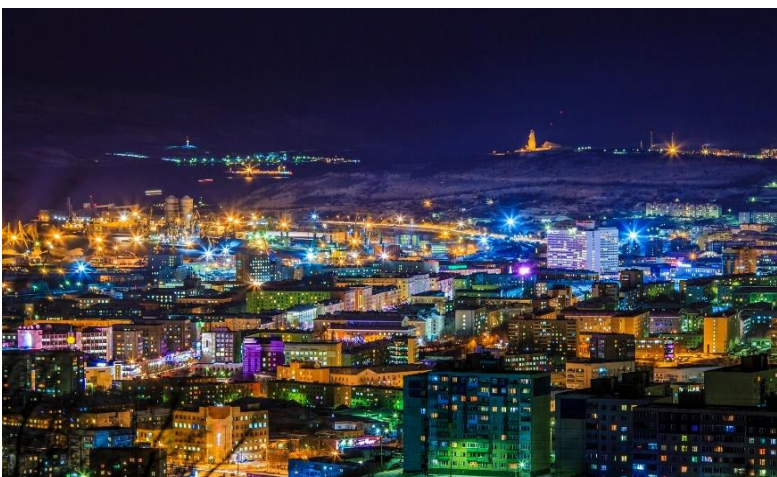
EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The Forum venues are furnished with modern safety equipment, including video surveillance and fire extinguishing systems.

In case of evacuation announcement, participants should:

- keep calm and follow instructions of the Forum staff, the police and other persons responsible for maintaining public order and fire safety as well as the voice alarm instructions;
- not interfere with rescue personnel, police and transport operations;
- leave the venue according to the evacuation plans and follow the exit signs;
- give way to vehicles with sound and light signalling devices.

USEFUL INFORMATION ABOUT MURMANSK

Murmansk Region is full-fledged Arctic. Located on the Kola Peninsula in the northwestern part of Russia, the region lies almost entirely beyond the Arctic Circle, that is why it is called the Polar Region.

The Hero City of Murmansk is the capital of the Polar Region and the largest city in the world above the Arctic Circle. It serves as a major logistics hub, home to the world's only nuclear-powered icebreaker fleet, and a key strategic outpost of Russia in the Arctic.

Murmansk is also the starting point of the Northern Sea Route, a vital maritime corridor that provides the shortest passage between continents and opens new opportunities for economic development.

ATTRACTIONS AND TOURISM IN MURMANSK

A flight from Moscow to Murmansk takes approximately two hours, making this the most accessible gateway to the Arctic. The region offers diverse opportunities for adventure – hunting and fishing, skiing and mountaineering, kiting and diving, reindeer and dog sledding, rafting, cultural and pilgrimage tourism, and Arctic cuisine tastings.

Visitors can also embark on whale-watching tours in Teriberka, chase the magical Northern Lights, or even travel to the North Pole aboard a nuclear icebreaker.

Within the city, key attractions include Heroes' Alley, the Alyosha Monument – Russia's second-largest monument and a symbol of the courage and resilience of the defenders of the Arctic – and the Lenin, the world's first nuclear-powered icebreaker.

Following its renovation, the Murmansk Regional Museum of Local Lore has reopened, offering visitors an immersive experience into the region's rich history and unique culture.

The Northern Lights are best viewed outside the city in designated observation areas.
