Ministerial meeting of the Arctic Council is scheduled for 19-20 May

Ambassador-at-large of the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs for International Cooperation in the Arctic, senior official in the Arctic Council Nikolay Korchunov spoke at the online briefing in Rossiya Segodnya following the Senior Arctic Officials' meeting that took place online on 16–18 March 2021.

According to Mr. Korchunov, the Senior Arctic Officials' meeting focus on preparation of the Ministerial meeting of the Arctic Council scheduled for 19–20 May 2021.

The Arctic Council was established in 1996 in accordance with the Ottawa Declaration. It is a high-level intergovernmental forum that ensures cooperation in the region, especially environmental efforts. Members of the Council are Denmark (including Greenland and Faroe Islands), Iceland, Canada, Norway, Russia, the USA, Finland, and Sweden.

Three Russian nuclear submarines simultaneously broke the ice in the Arctic for the first time

For the first time in the history of the Russian Navy, three nuclear submarines simultaneously surfaced in the Arctic within a 300-metre radius and broke 5-foot-thick ice. It occurred during the integrated Arctic expedition Umka-2021 that started on 20 March. Admiral Nikolay Evmenov, Commander of the Russian Navy, reported on the status of the expedition to President Putin.

Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic selected banks for discounted loans for Arctic zone

The list includes six authorized banks: VTB, Sber, Gazprombank, Sovkombank, Otkritie, and Moscow Industrial Bank. They can potentially participate in the discounted loan programme for residents of the Russian Arctic zone.

These banks will offer loans with a discounted interest rate in accordance with the rules approved by a decree of the Russian Government in December last year. Under this programme, the final rate will be lower than the market one by 1.5 times of the key interest rate set by the Bank of Russia (currently, 4,5% * 1,5 = 6,75%). It can be as low as 2% p.a.



Subsidies for residents of the Russian Arctic zone will be provided by the federal budget.

Komi will provide first 'Arctic hectares' on 1 August

The draft federal law provides for free land plots of 1 hectare per family member for five years. After that, the land can be subject to either privatization or long-term rent.

This land can be used for constructing housing or for any type of economic activity.

Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic and Ministry of Trade coordinate support measures for industry in the Far East

Deputy Prime Minister Yury Borisov and Yury Trutnev, Acting Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District, held a meeting with heads of Far Eastern regions. During the meeting, the Ministry of Trade and the Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic were assigned with coordinating existing support measures for Far Eastern operational facilities.

"We need to come up with such a cooperation system to help the two federal ministries account for each other's work to support operations. It will make their joint efforts more efficient," noted Yury Trutnev, Acting Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District.

In his turn, Yury Borisov stated that despite the crisis caused by the pandemic, steps to restore industrial production in the Far East and help it grow needed to be taken at present time. It also applies to actions to support employment and preservation of jobs in industry.

According to Mr. Borisov, the Government plans to focus on the efficiency of the existing support measures with approved financing, as well as potential non-financial tools, such as tariff and customs regulation, special economic zones and territories of advanced development.

Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic proposes an ecotourism fund in FEFD

Minister for the Development of the Far East and Arctic Alexey Chekunkov proposed to establish a fund for developing ecotourism in the Far East through an environmental fee for coal loading in seaports.

This measure will ensure support for ecotourism of over RUB 2.5 billion annually. With over 100 mln tonnes of coal in seaports each year, it will also provide additional income to Far Eastern residents involved in tourism.

Second hectare: Russians will get more land in the Far East

The Government has introduced a bill in the State Duma to grant a second Far Eastern hectare to programme participants who have successfully used the first. It is expected that the second hectare will be available this August. Programme participants will need to submit an application on the НаДальний Восток.рф website.

The Far Eastern Hectare programme was launched five years ago (in 2016) with the aim of attracting new residents to the Russian Far East and helping to improve living conditions for indigenous people.

Mikhail Mishustin ordered to resolve the issue with financing for the Children of the Arctic programme

Mr. Mishustin has instructed the Ministry of Economic Development, the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Labour and the Ministry of Finance to work out the sources of funding for the Children of the Arctic programme by 30 May, as well as the possibility of including it in the state programme for the socioeconomic development of Russia's Arctic zone.

The Children of the Arctic programme is designed to support new forms of education that take into account the climatic and cultural features of life of the indigenous minorities of the North, to improve the health of children, and to develop and publish textbooks.

Each FEFD region will get coordination centre for the Far East development programme

Each region of the Far Eastern Federal District will get a designated centre for coordinating measures under the Far East development programme. It was announced by Grigory Smolyak, Director of Human Capital and Territorial Development Department of the Russian Ministry for the Development of the Far East and Arctic.

He recalled that the national programme combines national projects and sectoral state programmes for the development of the Far Eastern regions. "In fact, the decisions, plans, and measures that will be implemented in the District in the near future have all been collected in one place. What needs to be achieved by 2024 in the macroregion is to exceed the national average growth rates of the quality of life and to improve economic indicators, in particular, to create at least 200 facilities in the advanced development territories and in the Free Port of Vladivostok," said Mr. Smolyak, noting that by 2035, the outflow of population from the Far East must be stopped.

New approaches to promoting the Arctic agenda

Between May 2021 and 2023, Russia will chair the Arctic Council. Over this time, many regions of the country will host over 80 events that will address the most relevant topics for the Arctic development. They can also become an important platform for promoting projects and initiatives proposed by the expert community.

As part of the preparation for Russian Chairmanship in the Arctic Council, Advisor to the President of the Russian Federation Anton Kobyakov met with voyager Fyodor Konyukhov. They discussed the strategic location





of the Arctic and activity to preserve its unique environment.

According to Mr. Kobyakov, "Opportunities the Arctic offers require an educated and careful approach to preserving this unique and vulnerable ecosystem for future generations."

In his turn, Fyodor Konyukhov, whose scientific discoveries are now used in developing instruments adapted for the Arctic's extreme conditions, noted: "Expeditions and research that we organize will facilitate Arctic countries and indigenous peoples to unite behind Russia in pursuing sustainable development and environmental protection of the region."

VEB.RF will invest in developing transport and logistics infrastructure in the Far East

VEB.RF has proposed to comprehensively modernize public transport systems in Khabarovsk Territory and Amur Region, involving not only fleet renewal but also a new ideology for managing the transport system. As experience in other regions has shown, the reform takes the quality, comfort and safety of public transport to a whole new level.

Projects involving the development of transport hubs are in high demand in the Far East. Renovating the airport complexes in Khabarovsk and Blagoveshchensk will make the cities the largest regional hubs in the Far East, create conditions for expanding the route network in the Far Eastern Federal District, increase passenger traffic, including attracting foreign tourists, and most importantly, improve the quality of passenger service.

Yury Trutnev inspected construction of a railway bridge from the Jewish Autonomous Region to China

The Nizhneleninskoye–Tongjiang railway bridge will be part of a new export route and an incentive for the creation of new logistics and industrial clusters, and will improve transport accessibility for several Far Eastern regions at once. It is planned that at the first stage, the freight turnover through the bridge will reach 5.2 million tonnes a year, and then, after the reconstruction of the Birobidzhan–Leninsk railway section, the turnover will increase to 20 million tonnes a year.

"The Government of the Russian Federation instructed us to create a border control point for all types of cargo. We'll see to it," noted Yury Trutnev, Acting Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District.
